Our Mission & Why it Matters

The One New Heart Tanzania (TONHT) is a non-profit organization dedicated to ensuring that children and adults in Tanzania do not die from treatable heart conditions due to lack of access, awareness or resources.

We work at the intersection of:

- Life-saving treatment
- Early diagnosis
- Community awareness
- Advocacy and capacity building
- Global partnerships

In 2025, our work reached communities from **Mbeya to Songwe, Rukwa to Dar es Salaam**, and extended globally through strategic partnerships in **India, the United States and Europe**.

Why Heart Disease in Tanzania is Urgent

- Congenital heart defects affect **8 in every 1,000 live births**
- Cardiovascular disease caused an estimated **56,908 deaths in Tanzania (2021)**
- **Hypertension affects ~26% of adults**, yet awareness and control remain low
- Diagnostic tools such as **ECG and Echo are available in less than half of health facilities**

With early detection and timely treatment, many of these deaths are preventable.

Lives Saved & Communities Reached

1. Life-Saving Surgeries for Children

In 2025, TONHT supported three children to receive life-saving heart surgery.

These children are now living healthy, active lives, outcomes that would not have been possible without donor support, partnerships and early diagnosis.

Impact:

- Lives saved
- Families protected from catastrophic health costs
- Proof that early detection and referral works



2. Early Diagnosis Through Community Screening

TONHT conducted multiple outreach screening camps using portable ECG and Echo technology, reaching underserved and rural communities.

Screening Impact

- **750+** people screened
- **150+** high-risk individuals referred
- Conditions identified included:
 - Hypertensive heart disease
 - Arrhythmias
 - Ischemic heart disease
 - Congenital heart defects

These outreaches brought services hundreds of kilometers closer to people who would otherwise never access cardiac care.



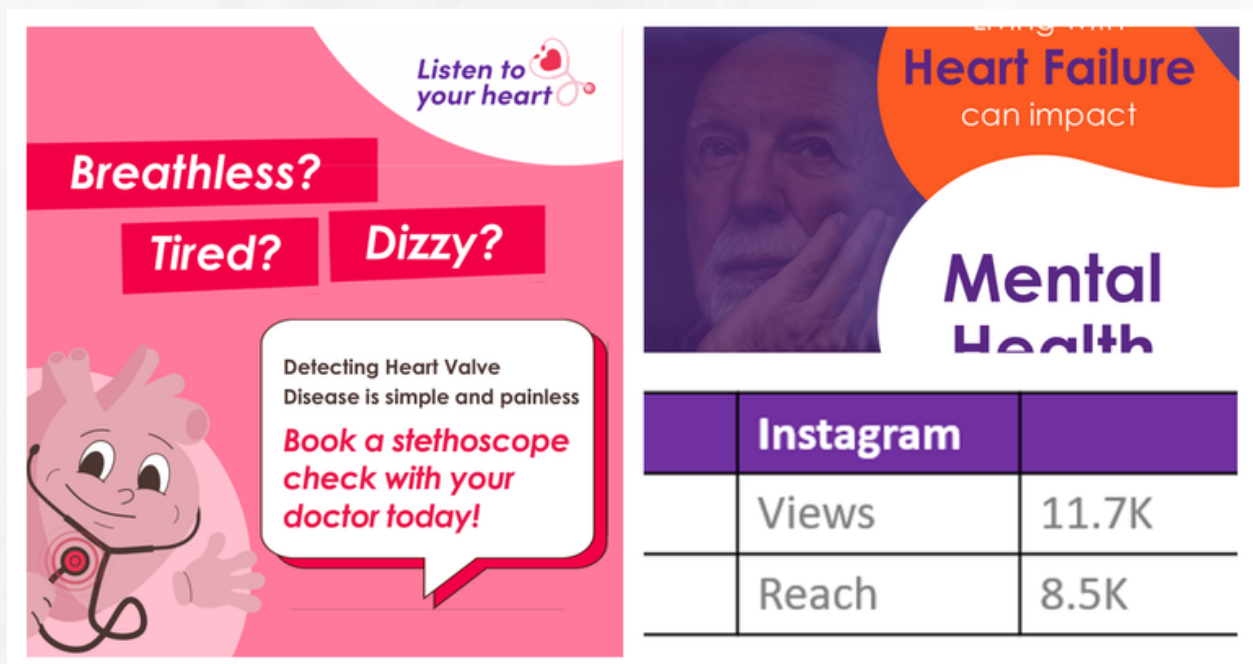
Awareness, Advocacy & Global Reach

1. Global Heart Hub 2025 Heart Failure Awareness Campaign

Highlighting the link between heart failure and diabetes, kidney disease, obesity and hypertension.

Impact:

- Improved health literacy
- Earlier care-seeking behavior
- Stronger community trust

2. Advocacy Beyond Borders

In 2025, TONHT represented Tanzania on global platforms, including:

- African Heart Conference (Cardiotan 2025) - Zanzibar
- Global Heart Hub Advocacy Training - Milan, Italy
- Global Heart Hub Unite Summit - Dublin, Ireland
- Diaspora engagement events in the USA (URITHIFEST 2025)
- Emory University - Atlanta Georgia
- Black Heart Association mobile heart screening - Dallas, Texas

These platforms amplified Tanzanian patient voices and ensured local realities inform global cardiovascular policy discussions.

Building Sustainable Systems

1. Strengthening Health Workforce Capacity

TONHT invested in long-term system change by strengthening partnerships with academic and clinical institutions:

- Emory University (USA) - Nursing leadership, NCD research and technology-enabled care
- University of Chicago
- JKCI, Mbeya Zonal Referral Hospital, Benjamin Mkapa Hospital to create local heart care pathways

A key focus area is **nursing capacity**, recognizing nurses as frontline leaders in early diagnosis, patient education and chronic disease management.

2. Institutional Growth & Sustainability

In 2025, TONHT achieved two major milestones:

1. The One New Heart Foundation (USA) obtained 501(c)(3) status, enabling:

- Tax-deductible donations
- Stronger international fundraising
- Increased donor confidence and transparency

2. Integrated Sustainability Model

- Supported by **One Heart Travel Limited**, a Tanzania-registered tourism social enterprise
- 50% of profits are dedicated to sponsoring free heart surgeries for needy children

This blended non-profit and social enterprise model reduces donor dependency and ensures long-term impact.
